Un «candidato de Manchuria» es un sujeto al que se ha lavado el cerebro y programado para matar, activado mediante una señal en apariencia intrascendente, sin conservar recuerdo de ello. El término proviene de la novela *The Manchurian Candidate* (1959) llevada al cine en 1962 por John Frankenheimer-, cuyo autor, Richard Condon, se inspiró a su vez en una confidencia hecha por un agente de la CIA, que le relató la amnesia sufrida por soldados norteamericanos hechos prisioneros en Corea, tras su cautiverio en algún lugar de Manchuria. Tras abandonar su puesto escribió un libro junto con Victor Marchetti sobre la necesidad de reformar la CIA: *The CIA and the Cult of Intelligence* (1974). La CIA censuró cerca del diez por ciento de la obra antes de permitir su publicación.
