Each statement has been referenced, and the original spelling and punctuation have been preserved; however, the sources cited will not be readily available to most members. study or teach from this book. Members need not purchase additional references and commentaries to study or teach these chapters. The text provided in this book, accompanied by the scriptures, is sufficient for instruction. The book may have been aided by a less stilted, impersonal tone; we know from the author's biography that Johnson converted to Mormonism thirty years ago, but we never learn why. The authors refer to each other as "Mr. Johnson" and "Rabbi Leffler," rather formal titles for men who have been friends for half a century. A perpetuating sense that this is not an interfaith conversation but a standard debate, with a projected winner and loser.
