In these two cases, some of the Halakhic authorities rule that there is no necessity for a Get in order to terminate the marriage. We will consider the early Halakhic rulings in these cases and the modern version of this suggestion, which was also rejected by modern Halakhic authorities. We will also undertake a comparative study of a possible parallel to the marriage for a pre-determined period - the Shi'ite Temporary Marriage, which is intentionally restricted to an agreed period of time and does not require divorce to annul it. We will conclude our discussion by revealing the possible common roots for the Temporary Marriage and the Shi'ite Temporary Marriage in ancient Persian law.
